

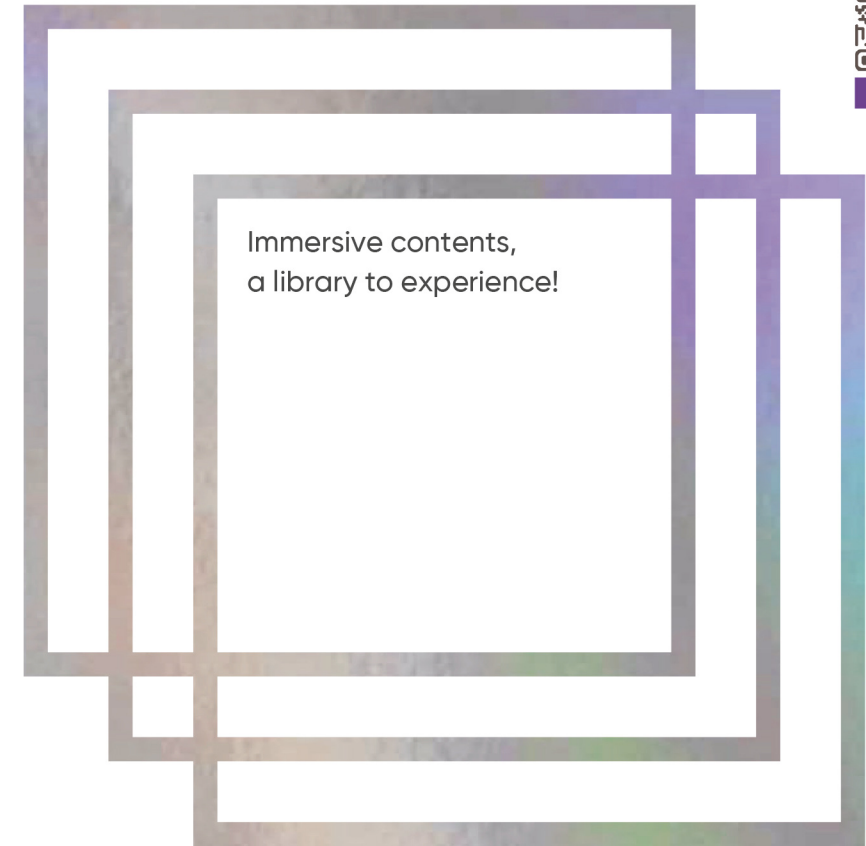

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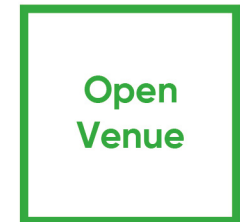

The future storage of the National Library of Korea, the repository of national knowledge and information (庫), is produced in 3D video, in an overwhelming way on a large 300-inch media wall



AI Shilgam Seojae

The AI Shilgam Seojae is an intelligent book curation system that combines physical books with interactive projection mapping. It offers intelligent features such as 'One-line briefing', 'Reading compass', and 'Multimedia content', 'Comparison of Two Books', 'AI Librarian'. Through a smart bookshelf connected to the table, users can intuitively search for books.



Digital Book

Immersive content that can provide translations of the old collection or allow experiencing lively multimedia information in response to the user's action of turning the page and touching the book

Interactive Maps

Immersive content that shows the old map of the National Library of Korea in detail with high-resolution images and allows to experience various information contained in the map

Works included | 「Suseon jeondo(首善全圖)」(Estimated to be from 1840), 「Mokjang jido(牧場地圖, Maps of Ranches)」(1678), 「Yeojido(輿地圖)」(After 1776), 「Joseonpungsokdo(朝鮮風俗圖)」(Year unknown)

Standby video | 「Paldojuyudo」(Kwak Ho-jung)



Immersive Media Wall

Immersive media content that realizes old maps in 32K high resolution on QLED-only displays

Works included | 「Cheonggudo(靑邱圖)」(Estimated to be from 1846-1849)



XR Art Museum

The National Library of Korea's valuable materials "Samjae Paintings" and "Daewongun Unran" can be enjoyed in a virtual space in ultra-high resolution, just like looking at them at an art museum

Works included | 「Samjae Paintings(三齋書帖)」(Estimated to be from 1674-1720), 「Daewongun Unran(大院君雲蘭)」(1879)

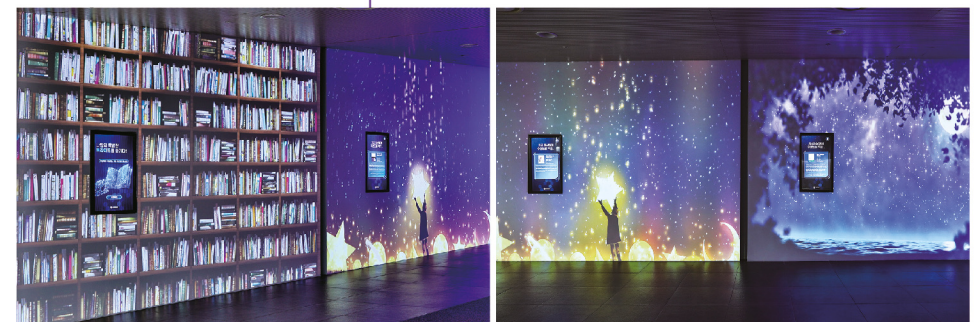

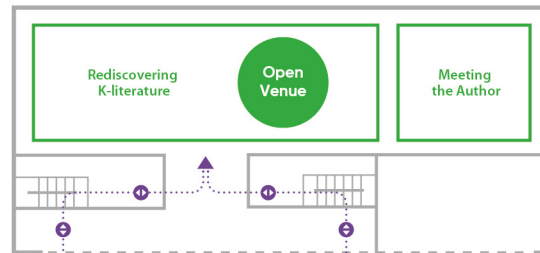

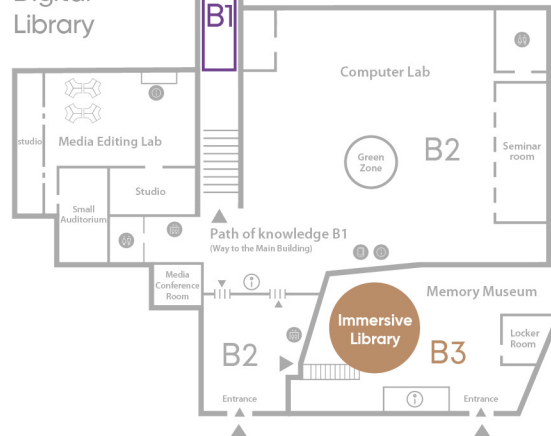
